How to use your NevaAlone device

If you experience a fall or medical emergency in the home or garden, you can call for help using your medical unit by either:

- Pressing the HELP (red) button on the medical unit;
 OR
- 2. Pressing the HELP (grey) button on your Wristwatch / Pendant for 2 seconds.

The HELP (red) button will now flash slowly indicating the unit has called for help.
