

How to host an ACN Connect 2020 watch party A complete guide

Keen to host ACN Connect 2020 at your place? Follow this guide to become the ultimate host and throw a COVID-safe watch party for your team!



STEP 1:

Gather your team

Team members are located far and wide but given the varying COVID-19 restrictions across the country, your watch party will be attended by team members in your neighbourhood.

Talk to them about your watch party and get a headcount of keen partygoers, keeping in mind the current daily limit of household visitors in your State. Use the COVID-19 Restriction Checker to find out the limit on how many people can visit a home in your State.

Visit your state/territory government website to view the latest news and updates on COVID-19.



STEP 2:

Build buzz and excitement for ACN Connect 2020Create a watch party group in your preferred messaging app.

STEP 3:

#LevelUp your watch party

- Channel the team spirit and give your watch party a theme!
 Decorate your lounge room and dress-up in theme. A colour that represents your team? A real-life figure that you all admire? Get creative!
- What's a watch party without snacks or as we would like to call it, "brain food"! Ask your team to bring a brain food plate each. Stay COVID-safe and avoid share plates and finger foods – individual serving is highly recommended.



STEP 4:

Set up your tech

Team theme - check. Brain food – check. Tech – uh oh.

Don't let the bad times roll. Avoid technical issues on the day of ACN Connect 2020 and make sure that your devices are set-up the night before. For a better experience, we recommend viewing ACN Connect 2020 on your TV. Use AirPlay if you have an Apple TV or AirPlay-enabled TV, or mirror your screen with Chromecast or connect via HDMI. The most important thing to remember and do is to stay COVID-safe at all times during your watch party.

- If you have any COVID-19 symptoms or have experienced COVID-19 symptoms in the past 14 days, including fever and respiratory symptoms, or have had contact with a known or suspected COVID-19 case, please do not attend or host a watch party.
- Follow your state/territory government restrictions.
- What you can and can't do in your state or territory is constantly changing – visit your state/territory government website to get the latest updates on COVID-19 restrictions.
- Remember, you still need to adhere to the golden rules wash your hands, keep your distance and be safe!
- To protect yourself and others, please avoid physical greetings such as handshaking, hugs and kisses, and promote good hygiene as well as provide alcohol-based hand rub.
- Please avoid over-inviting and ensure that you are following the limit on household visitors. This will allow you and your guests to practise safe distancing wherever possible inside and outside the house.
